8. Cross review visit 2010-11- Swanirvar

In 2010-11, 17 Govt. teachers came for a peer review process to see what we are doing in our schools and they were highly pleased and praised us. This year 25 SSK teachers, 35 NGO-teachers and 6 Govt. teachers



came to visit our primary schools as well as some of our partner Govt. schools where we are continuously providing our inputs in the form of trainings, workshops and seminars. They took extensive notes and gave their opinions in the meeting on classroom management and pedagogy (Bengali, Maths, English and EVS). They saw group works, classroom management, use of TLMs, teacher's work plans, assembly, children's committees and their roles, 1 village maps making and question-answer sessions.

After visiting the schools they all sat together at Swanirvar to discuss everything they had seen. They also discussed all family and school relationships, teacher's attitude towards weak children and classroom management. The visiting teachers suggested for some changes and praised this new system. Two of them wanted to implement the Swanirvar's process in their own schools.

8A. Teachers conference on RTE (Right to Education)

The program was organized in association with Vikramshila Education resource society, kolkata on 11th Aug 2010 at baduria municipality community hall.

126 Govt. Primary teachers, 41 SSK sahayika , 46 high school teacher, 96 NGO teachers & representative , 11 other officials participated in this program.



9. Exposure visit by the other NGO teachers to see our ‘Peer Review System’:

In our own schools we have had a system of “peer review” for many years where teachers from 2 schools visit the third school and spend the whole day observing. At the end of the day they sit with the teachers and share what they have observed . We have found this very effective. The teachers took extensive notes and gave detailed feedback both class-wise and subject wise. They saw board works , group works , hands on activities, use of TLMs , performance during assembly class , class on family history and drawing village , question – answer sessions. The teachers participated wholeheartedly in the process of being critical of certain things and suggesting changes and also appreciating what they liked. They felt that this was an excellent way of all-round learning for teachers. Baikunthpur Shishu Seva Kendra, NGO from South 24 parganas brought 33 SSK sahiyikas , members of their managing committee and volunteer, teachers visited swanirvar primary school , SSK school & govt. pri. School. They tried to learn the Peer Review System.

10. Training Module

We have 17 days program on Primary Training module in 3 phases. Last year we developed 2 phase training module. This year we had developed 3rd phase training module (duration 6 days).

11. Training Visit

a) Pre training visit to Purulia

We visited Pradan at Dist.-Purulia for Pre training requirement analysis. We collected all the information & details to strengthen teachers ability, teacher student relationship, better skills, improve weak childrens, monitoring system. TLM usage evaluation system guidelines regarding academic role of supervisor Parents committee role & guidelines to be framed

b) Follow up visit to west Midnapore

This visit was to inspect the training impact on our training provided -the points were to look on teachers ability, teacher student relationship, skill development, dealing with weak children.

12. English Classroom Decoration

This year we decided to make one special room in three of our primary schools for English training. These class rooms were decorated with lots of TLMs and Charts and Posters. Our student had drawn a number of pictures on the walls.

13. Swanirvar teachers visit Govt. schools regularly

On every week Swanirvar teachers go to govt. pri. Schools for classroom inputs like TLM work , group work , experiments , field work. Friendship program, children committee, conducts parents meeting & workshop. These inputs were given to 30 schools every week with the help of 12 swanirvar pri. Teachers.

14. Children Committee

In our primary schools we have had children's committees for several years. We have gradually started introducing in govt schools also.. Now govt. schools have students committees with responsibility for cleanliness, sports, water, library, the sahitya sabha, mid day meal. We are also trying to introduce a system which is functioning in our schools where these committees have to present a report of their work each month to the whole school and answer any questions from the students. We believe such practices will instill functional democratic habits and that it is extremely important to start this habit formation from an early age before it is too late.

Children committees in Swanirvar School

In 3 pri. School, we have 6 children committee in each school which consists of building cleaning, library, sahitya sabha, sports, water, and food. In every last friday of the month they do evaluation committee meeting which is done by the leader of the committee.

The leader gives his views and others members participate by giving their views in favour or against the views to come to a conclusion. Finally there is ranking based on the inputs from all the members of the committee. In the last 4 months we had 4 evaluation meeting.

Children committees in Govt school

In last year the 15 children committee were constituted in the govt schools .

In this year 4 schools were added to the above tally of 15. In these children committee meeting there were lot of improvement & up gradation in the committees descisions for e.g bhojpara fatulla pur Purba Para FP school the cleaning committee made compulsory to use soap for cleaning hands before having meals. Kalinga adarsha school made a checklist to supervise that all the children are taking library books or not.

15. Field Trip to Taragunia Mintu Park, Baduria 2010-11

The Field Trip is an important annual event in Swanirvar-schools. Every year both teachers and students sit for a discussion where they would go for their field trip. They also discussed about the group works that the students would carry out at the site during their field trip. This year they decided class I&II would visit their local areas and both the students of class III &IV would visit Taragunia Mintu Park .
